**Design Area:** 2.86" x 5.00" (40 x 70 stitches)

## Backstitch Lines:

 DMC-154 grape - vy lt (34.60 inches, 0.1 skeins)	 DMC-554 violet - lt (32.84 inches, 0.1 skeins)
 DMC-310 black (28.57 inches, 0.1 skeins)	 DMC-814 garnet - dk (32.32 inches, 0.1 skeins)
 DMC-347 salmon - vy dk (46.25 inches, 0.1 skeins)	

Welcome to the February part of the Blackwork SAL!

This is the rectangles pattern.

As you are doing rectangles you can do them all! Just pick where you want to stitch each bit of pattern and have fun!

## Notes:

- I have made the pattern so it fits on one page for the pattern and a single page for the notes.
- I have given a full rectangle only - if you are doing an edge shape this time just do only the bit that falls within the shape you have chosen this month (there are just too many options for me to draw them all for you, sorry.)
- If you are doing a vertical rectangle you can choose to either rotate the pattern 90 degrees (a quarter turn) or start at the top and fill the width of your shape following the pattern, then just keep the repeats as you go downwards.
