

DMC-444 lemon - dk	(19.91 inches, 0.1 skeins)	— DMC-820 royal blue - vy dk	(69.88 inches, 0.1 skeins)

Notes:

When doing blackwork it's traditional to use the Holbein/double running stitch (tutorial: http://www.nordicneedle.net/2011/04/22/holbein-double-running-stitch/) however you can also use backstitch if you prefer.
