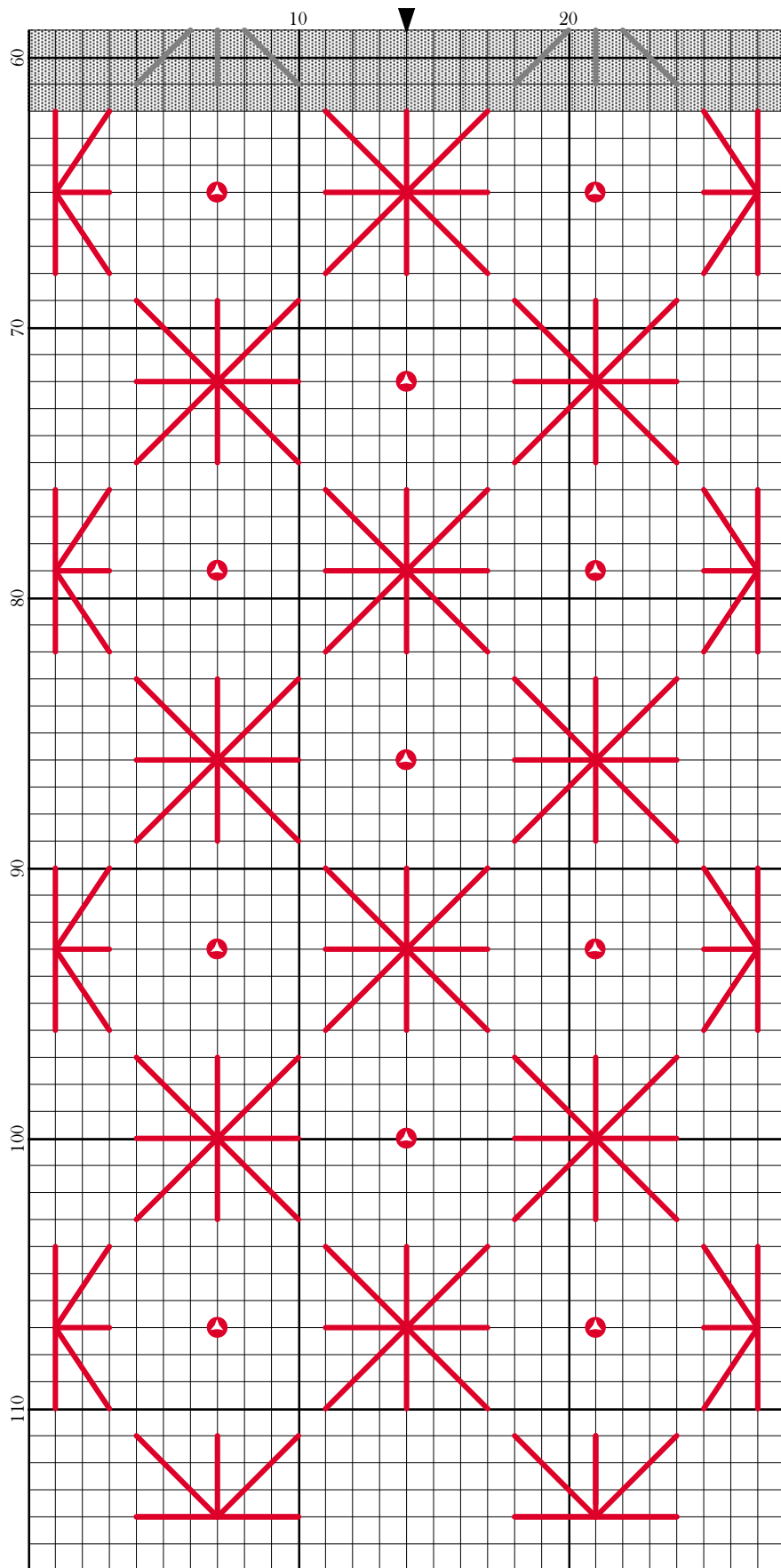

Welcome to the February edition of the Easy Christmas Cards SAL!

To do the stitching the way I did it start in a corner and go to the middle of each star shape, go round (either clockwise or counter clockwise, just be consistent) from the outer edge to the centre for each one.

Then for each "French Knot" marked on the pattern use a sequin and a bead to hold the sequin in place.
