[2] DMC 310* black (101 stitches, 0.1 skeins) [2] DMC 3865 winter white (556 stitches, 0.2 skeins) [2] DMC 912 emerald green - lt (246 stitches, 0.1 skeins)

(*) Blended Entries:

DMC-310 & DMC-550 (DMC Cotton-black blended with DMC Cotton-violet - vy dk)

Backstitch Lines:

— DMC-310* black (20.78 inches, 0.1 skeins) DMC-3865 winter white (0.25 inches, 0.2 skeins)

DMC-912 emerald green - lt (16.65 inches, 0.1 skeins)

French Knots:

• DMC-310* black (52 French knots)

Welcome to the eleventh of 12 monthly fobs in the returning Fob a Month! As usual, this month I also made a pincushion to go with the fob.

Notes:

- Make sure you stitch each piece at least 10 stitches away from the other pieces in every direction so you have enough space for the seam allowance. The pattern has them closer together to save on paper when printing.
- All backstitches that cross more than one square diagonally corner to corner are straight stitches.
- This month uses blended threads this is very easy! Just take one thread of each colour asked for and use them together in the needle as if they were the same colour that's all there is to it.
- As always you can use beads or colonial knots instead of French knots just do what you prefer.

Naturally you can always go ahead and use any colour you like for this! If you want them more poppy like you could for example use red.
