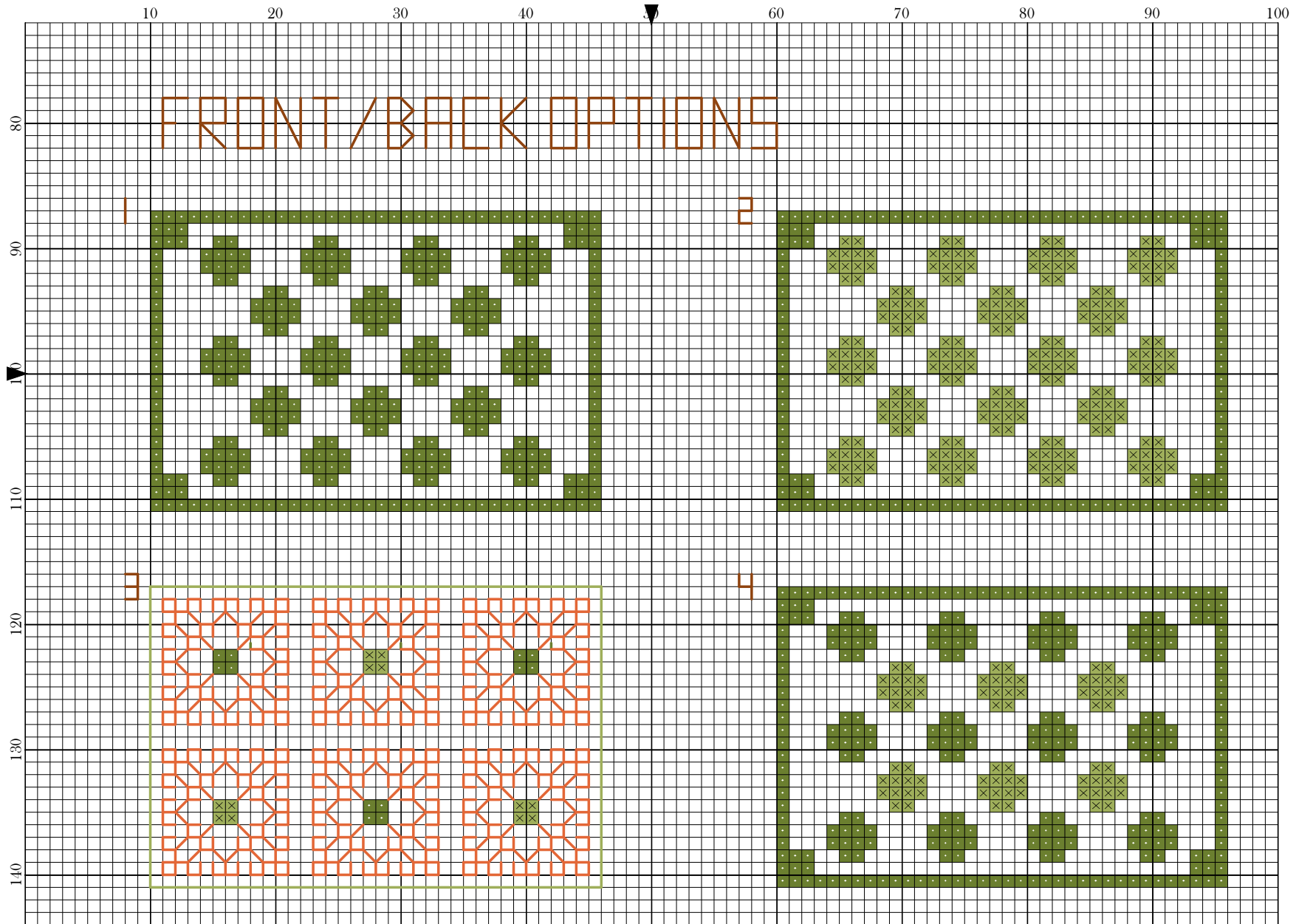
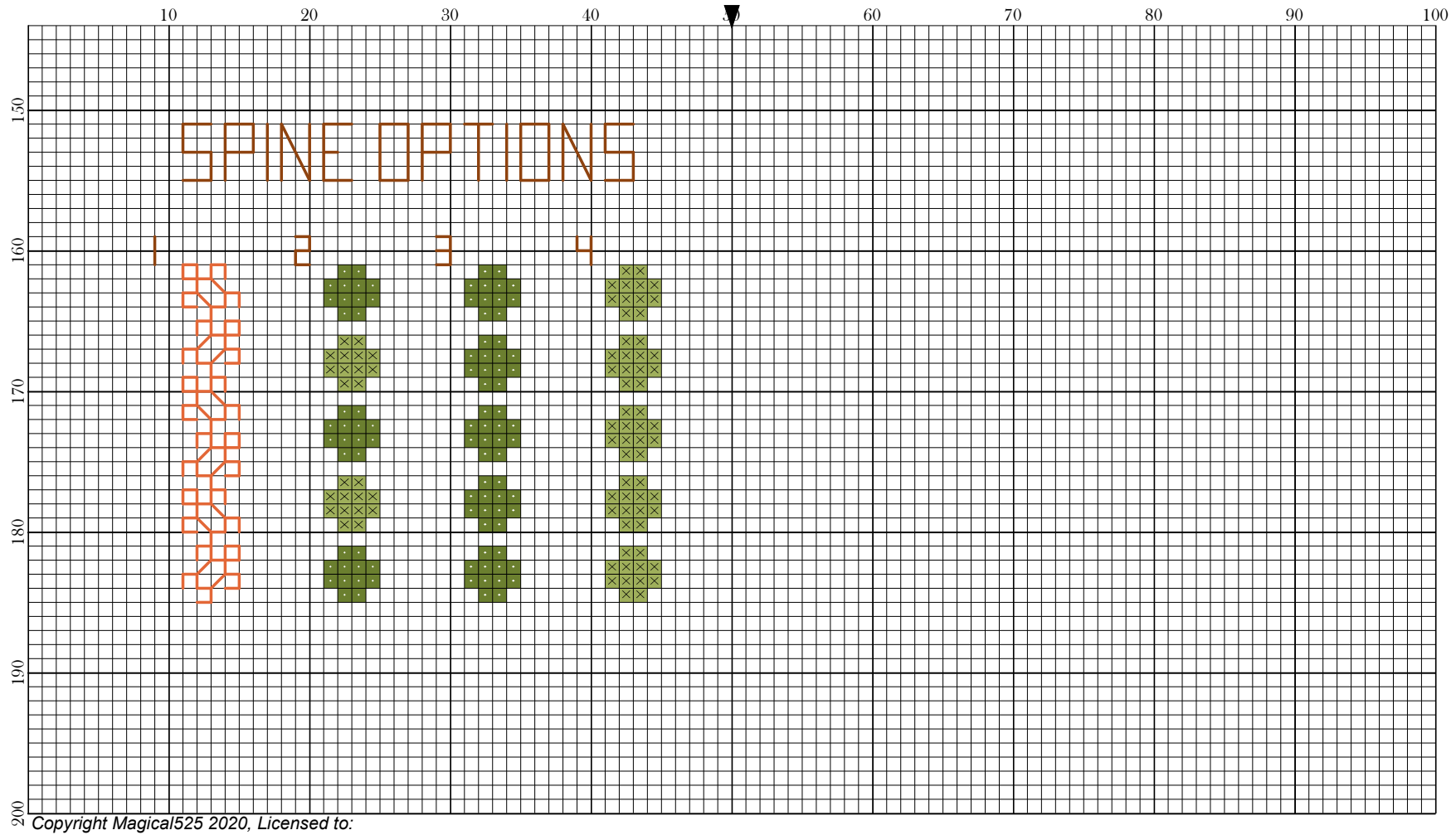

 DMC-470 avocado green - lt (8.57 inches, 0.2 skeins)  DMC-937 avocado green - md (19.25 inches, 0.4 skeins)
