I hope you enjoy this pattern which was originally started as Neglected Floss SAL hosted by Stitching Pirates on Deviant Art but is now hosted on my blog.

This year I decided to do a different pattern each month - what it is and what size it will be is a surprise but you will be able to stitch each one using a single colour thread or a variegated thread - or more if you decide to stitch the patterns using leftovers from other projects.

This is the September pattern.

This month uses both back and straight stitch. All stitches that cross more than one sitch corner to corner are straight stitches, all others are backstitch.
