Welcome to the sixth Ornament of the Month! June has four birthstones: Pearl, Moonstone, Pink Alexandrite, and Green Alexandrite and I made a pattern for each of them.

This is the pattern for Moonstone.

Please note that the back stitches are darker than the actual colour used as you cannot see them on the pattern if I use the real colour.

DMC 841 is not used for this pattern - it's to show where the DMC Ecrú backstitches go.

This year the patterns will be three shades of DMC linked to the birthstone of the month. Of course you can always use another thread if you so choose.

All stitches that cross more than one stitch corner to corner are straight stitches. If you use Aida it is a good idea to swap to a sharp pointed needle for the stitches that go half-way across a stitch.
