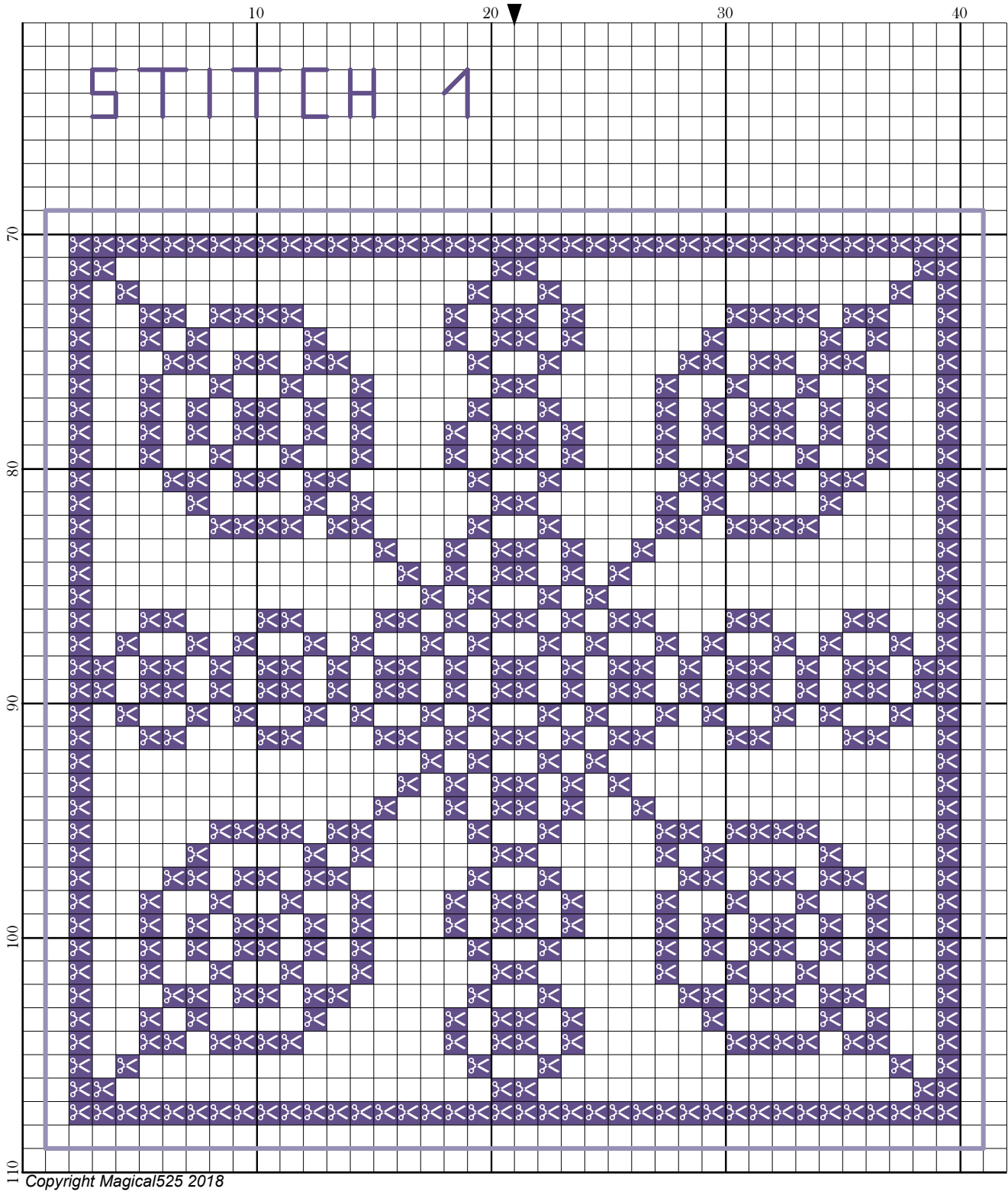

  [2] DMC 155 blue violet - md dk (21 stitches, 0.1 skeins)


  [2] DMC 333 blue violet - vy dk (664 stitches, 0.2 skeins)

Backstitch Lines:

 DMC-155 blue violet - md dk (22.47 inches, 0.1 skeins)

 DMC-333 blue violet - vy dk (6.21 inches, 0.2 skeins)

French Knots:

 DMC-155 blue violet - md dk (21 French knots)

This is the second of the Ornament of the Month patterns! For February I chose a dark violet.

Note: The lines joining the dark purple diamonds are all straight stitches, all other lines are backstitch.

If you'd like to add some bling to this pattern try using beads instead of french knots. I'd suggest using Mill Hill 02091 Purple Blue.

I only put one of the four triangles needed on the pattern to save paper since they are all exactly the same, please refer to the Stitching Template I have made in a separate pdf and included in the blog post.
