This is the seventh of the Ornament of the Month patterns! For July I chose a bright yellow.

Note: I have done the backstitches in black as the yellow just doesn't show up so well in the pattern.
For stitching order please consult the stitching key:

All lines that go across more than one space end to end are straight stitches, all other lines are backstitch.

If you'd like to add some bling to this pattern try using beads instead of french knots. I'd suggest using Mill Hill 42102 Lemon.

I only put one of the four triangles needed on the pattern to save paper since they are all exactly the same, please refer to the Stitching Template I have made in a separate pdf and included in the blog post.
