## Ornament of the Month - 2018 - May

**Design Area:** 2.22" x 6.00" (40 x 108 stitches)

[2] DMC 700 christmas green - br (725 stitches, 0.2 skeins)

**Backstitch Lines:** 

— DMC-702 kelly green (31.39 inches, 0.1 skeins) — DMC-700 christmas green - br (3.08 inches, 0.2 skeins)

French Knots:

**OMC-700** christmas green - br (17 French knots)

This is the fifth of the Ornament of the Month patterns! For May I chose a rich green - DMC calls it Christmas green and I have to say it is a great colour for Christmas stitching.

Note: All lines that go across more than one space end to end are straight stitches, all other lines are backstitch.

If you'd like to add some bling to this pattern try using beads instead of french knots. I'd suggest using Mill Hill 02054 Brilliant Shamrock.

I only put one of the four triangles needed on the pattern to save paper since they are all exactly the same, please refer to the Stitching Template I have made in a separate pdf and included in the blog post.
