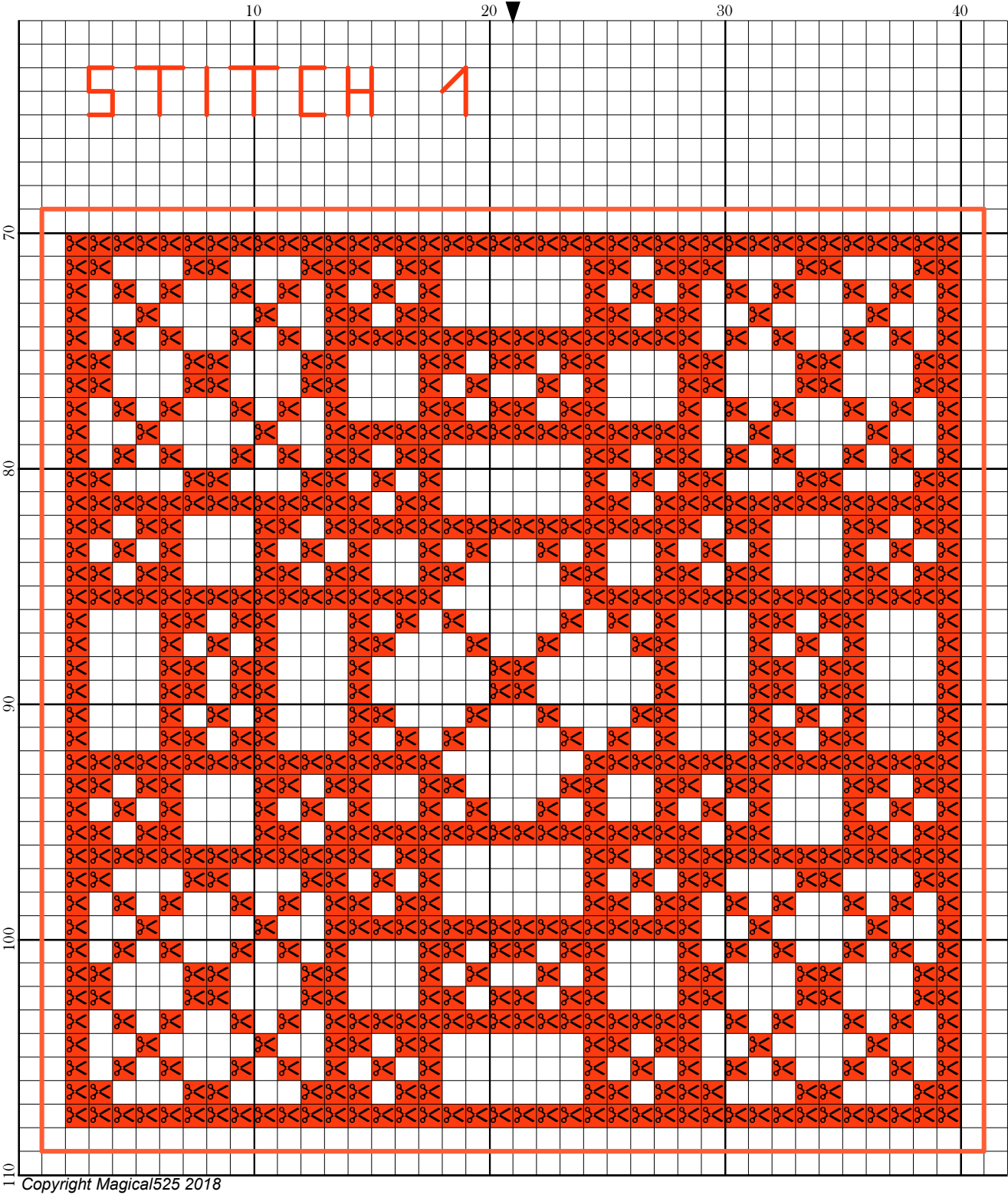

Ornament of the Month - 2018 - October

Backstitch Lines:

 DMC-608 bright orange (50.32 inches, 0.1 skeins)  DMC-606 burnt orange-red (3.08 inches, 0.3 skeins)

French Knots:

 DMC-606 burnt orange-red (67 French knots)

This is the tenth of the Ornament of the Month patterns! For October I chose a burnt orange.

All lines are straight stitches this month - it's a bit like lacing a corset.

The French knots/beads are supposed to be placed in the centre of each diamond shape but due to the limitations of the software that wasn't always possible to do in the pattern.

If you'd like to add some bling to this pattern try using beads instead of french knots. I'd suggest using Mill Hill 03043 Oriental Red.

I only put one of the four triangles needed on the pattern to save paper since they are all exactly the same, please refer to the Stitching Template I have made in a separate pdf and included in the blog post.
