Ornament of the Month 2019: January

This is the first of the 2019 Ornament of the Month patterns! For January I chose Copper.

The stars are done using straight stitches. You can either go from starting point to the end point for each line OR you can go from the outside point into the centre creating an eyelet stitch. It is normal for a hole to appear in the centre of these stitches.

Yes, there is a hole in the middle of the pattern! It's so you can either make a square "doughnut" ornament OR use the space to put an initial or the date.

This year the patterns will be one shade of DMC and one of Kreinik. If you don't want to buy many colours of Kreinik then it might be an idea to use the same colours for all of the ornaments. Of course you can always grab some DMC Light Effects instead or another thread entirely if you so choose.

If you don't like the idea of doing 52 French knots with Kreinik (Personally I wouldn't want to do this) then you could either use beads or the DMC used in the pattern.
