This is the third of the 2019 Ornament of the Month patterns! For March I chose gold - just keep it away from the leprechauns!

All stitches that cross more than one stitch corner to corner are straight stitches. If you use Aida it is a good idea to swap to a sharp pointed needle for the stitches that go half-way across a stitch.

Yes, there is a hole in the middle of the pattern! It's so you can either make a square doughnut ornament OR use the space to put an initial or the date.

This year the patterns will be one shade of DMC and one of Kreinik. If you don't want to buy many colours of Kreinik then it might be an idea to use the same colours for all of the ornaments. Of course you can always grab some DMC Light Effects instead or another thread entirely if you so choose.

If you don't like the idea of doing french knots with Kreinik (Personally I wouldn't want to do this) then you could either use beads or the DMC used in the pattern.

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
