Welcome to the December edition of the 2020 Ornament of the Month!

There are five beads this month - they are attached with a double sized cross stitch done using DMC 699 (the weird squiggle line on the pattern - don't worry you don't have to make yours squiggle!). I used a single strand to attach mine and went through the beads twice - once each way however you could use two strands and go through on the first half of the x and let each strand of the two threads fall around the bead on the way back.

All stitches that cross more than one square corner to corner are straight stitches.

Please make sure to leave sufficient space (10 stitches apart is enough, but you may prefer more) between the parts for seam allowance, the pattern parts are placed like this to save space on the page.

Refer to the tutorial linked in the post for instructions on how to assemble the ornament.
