Welcome to the June edition of the 2020 Ornament of the Month!

All lines that cross more than one stitch corner to corner are straight stitches, all others are backstitch.

Please make sure to leave sufficient space (10 stitches apart is enough, but you may prefer more) between the parts for seam allowance, the pattern parts are placed like this to save space on the page.

Refer to the tutorial linked in the post for instructions on how to assemble the ornament.
