As its pride month I thought it only right and proper to make a pattern to honour all the gay friends I've had over the years - all wonderful people as it happens - who in their own ways helped me become the person I am today.

If you'd prefer a less bright colour pallet for the star and heart I suggest the following colours instead:

DMC:

Red: 961
Orange: 3340
Yellow: 3823
Green: 164
Blue: 519
Purple: 210

Of course if you don't want to use lots of colours but use a single variegated thread there are quite a few manufacturers and small scale hand dyers who make them, here are some colour suggestions:

Anchor - 1335 - Rainbow

Weeks Dye Works - 4107 - Confetti

ThreadworX - 1154 - Bradley's Balloons

Jodyri Designs - 003 R - over the rainbow <http://jodyridesigns.com/products/003-over-the-rainbow>

If you know of any more rainbow threads please let me know and I'll add them to my blogpost for others to see :)
