This week's illuminated manuscript inspired pattern is of a French lily. You really want to use a super shiny gold for this one - it needs to give off that rich sparkly illuminated manuscript vibe. I used Kreinik 002J #4 Very Fine Braid as its glorious.

If you don't have DMC 796 on hand but you do have 820 that would work very well too. You could of course also use a lovely rich blue fabric and only stitch the gold.
