## Power Flower

**Design Area:** 2.67" x 2.67" (48 x 48 stitches)

**Backstitch Lines:** 

DMC-161 gray blue (1.11 inches, 0.1 skeins)
 DMC-820 royal blue - vy dk (66.25 inches, 0.1 skeins)

Although it doesn't look like it, this was inspired by a power outage that my bf had to deal with and the very nice customer service person on twitter @ssencommunity

There are 4 versions of this pattern - feel free to mix and match to create something with it, though I do suggest using either 14ct Aida or 28ct evenweave or linen as it's quite intricate and quickly loses its detail if you stitch on finer fabric.

## **Notes**

Each individual pattern is just 18 stitches square and on 14ct Aida, if you add 2 stitches on each side before stitching it together, it then comes out at 1 1/2" square.
