## **Backstitch Lines:**

KR4-002HL Gold Hi Lustre (67.48 inches, 0.2 skeins)

This week's illuminated manuscript inspired pattern is also of a Purple Psalter, this time it's the Rule of St. Benedict.

This pattern could be stitched on a purple fabric if you prefer - the stitching is a lot faster then!

If you don't like stitching crosses consider leaving out the central DMC 158 stitch and instead using that colour to stitch the central cross stitch of the + shapes to make them into flowers.
