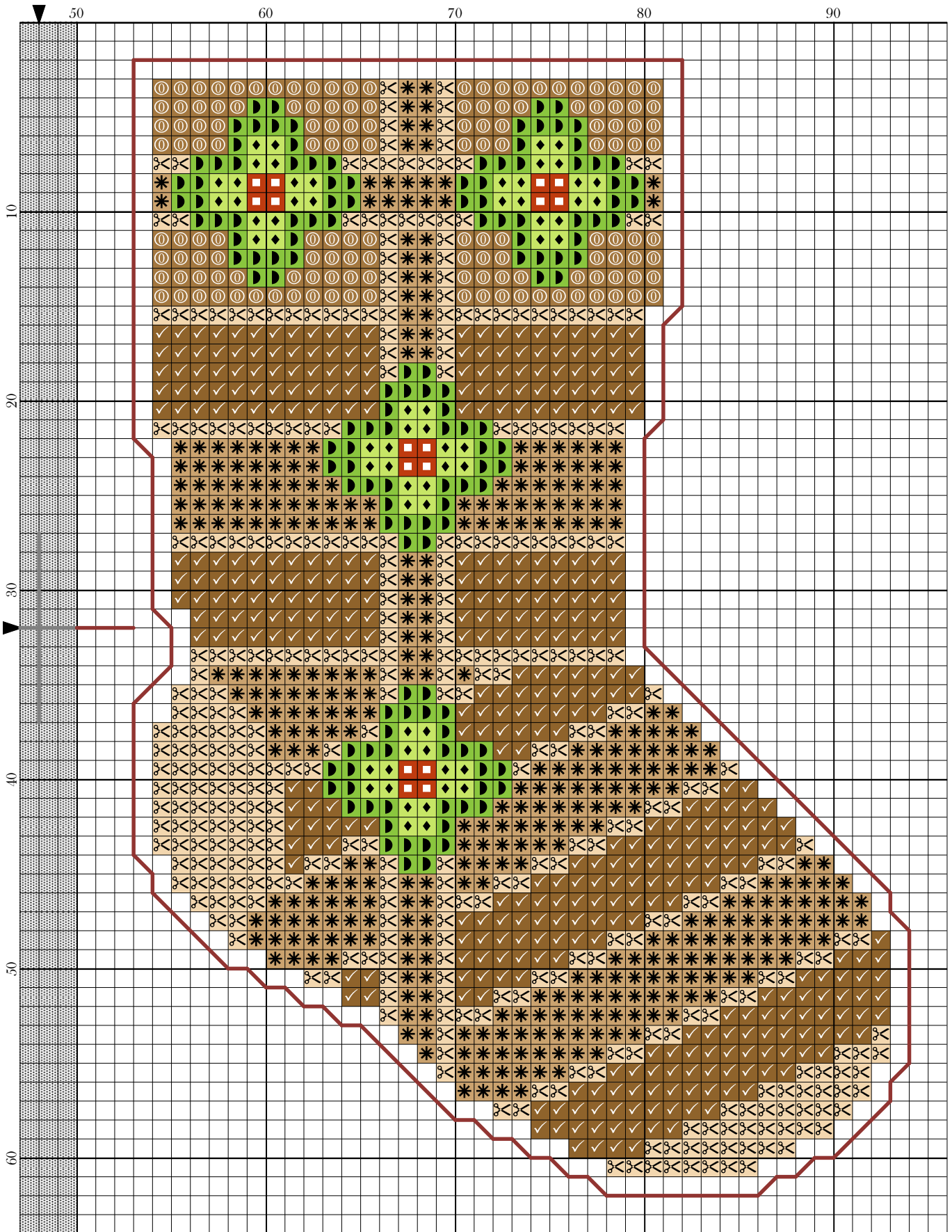

## Backstitch Lines:

 DMC-3777 terra cotta - vy dk (21.65 inches, 0.1 skeins)

This is the 7th of the 31 patterns that I will be giving on my blog over the month.

Today's pattern is inspired by the Mucha princess patterns Pinky the Pink has made, this one uses the colours of Pocahontas which you can find here: <http://tinyurl.com/yddscxhc> (if it hasn't sold out yet as it's a limited edition pattern). The Pocahontas pattern was only released last week so there isn't a fob pattern for her yet, but it's been made and will be released in August for a Friday freebie.

If you don't like the colours then by all means change them, it's your project so you should make it in colours you enjoy!

The + in the centre is the middle of the pattern, marked for your stitching ease. The brown backstitched line is the seam line of the stockings should you join them into a single stocking. I'd suggest whip stitching them together wrong sides facing.
