This is the 8th of the 31 patterns that I will be giving on my blog this month.

Today's pattern is inspired by a background in an illuminated manuscript. This one uses some Kreinik gold thread to give it some shine.

If you don't like the colours then by all means change them, it's your project so you should make it in colours you enjoy!

The + in the centre is the middle of the pattern, marked for your stitching ease. The black backstitched line is the seam line of the stockings should you join them into a single stocking. I'd suggest whip stitching them together wrong sides facing.
