

This is the 10th of the 31 patterns that I will be giving on my blog over the month.

Today's pattern is inspired by the mucha princess patterns Pinky the Pink has made, this one uses the colours of Tiana which you can find here: http://tinyurl.com/yd8ofsrc (if it hasn't sold out yet as it's a limited edition pattern). All diagonal lines should be done with a straight stitch - so the needle only goes through the fabric at the beginning and ending of the line.

This pattern calls for it to be mostly stitched with a light green, If you prefer you can use a light green fabric instead and just do the white cuff and straight stitched area's.

If you don't like the colours then by all means change them, it's your project so you should make it in colours you enjoy!

The + in the centre is the middle of the pattern, marked for your stitching ease. The brown backstitched line is the seam line of the stockings should you join them into a single stocking. I'd suggest whip stitching them together wrong sides facing.
