


This is the 12th of the 31 patterns that I will be giving on my blog over the month.

Today's pattern is taken from an illuminated manuscript and first used for my Celtic Wolf embroidery. Like the blue pattern on day 5 I wanted to use this to create a stocking so it had a chance to really shine - and with all the gold used it really does!

If you don't like the colours then by all means change them, it's your project so you should make it in colours you enjoy!

The + in the centre is the middle of the pattern, marked for your stitching ease. The black backstitched line is the seam line of the stockings should you join them into a single stocking. I'd suggest whip stitching them together wrong sides facing.
