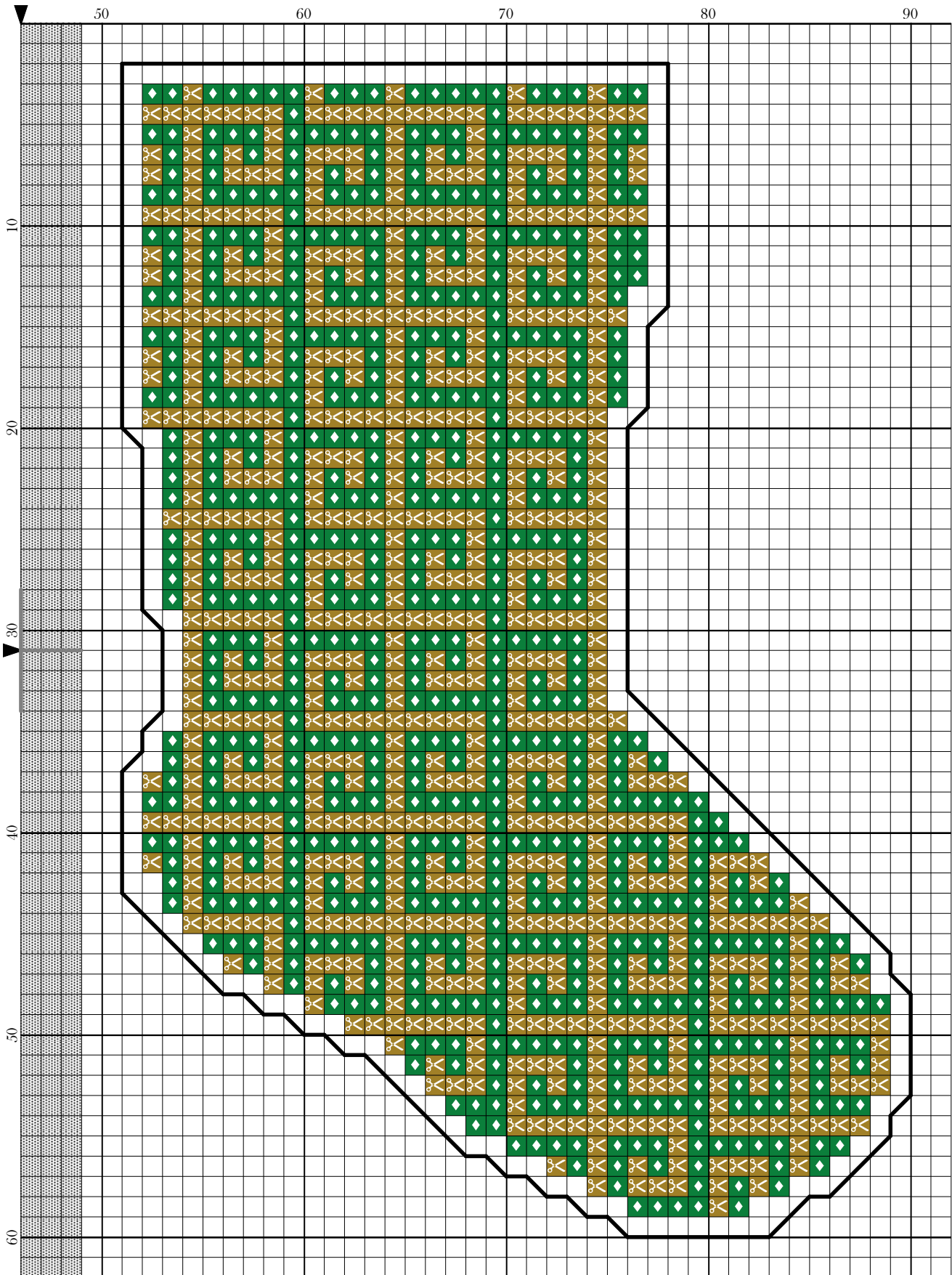

# Christmas in July - Day 15 - Celtic Green and Gold

## Backstitch Lines:

 DMC-310 black (20.31 inches, 0.1 skeins)

This is the 15th of the 31 patterns that I will be giving on my blog over the month.

Today's pattern is a simple Celtic repeat pattern made with green and gold thread. If you really don't want to use gold then perhaps DMC B5200 would be a good choice.

If you don't like the colours then by all means change them, it's your project so you should make it in colours you enjoy!

The + in the centre is the middle of the pattern, marked for your stitching ease. The black backstitched line is the seam line of the stockings should you join them into a single stocking. I'd suggest whip stitching them together wrong sides facing.
