



Christmas in July - Day 16 - Elsa

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Grid Size: 96W x 64H

Design Area: 5.11" x 3.33" (92 x 60 stitches)

 (1960 stitches, 0.6 skeins)

 (152 stitches, 0.1 skeins)

Backstitch Lines:

DMC-3839 lavender blue - md (9.60 inches, 0.1 skeins)

DMC-3838 lavender blue - dk (12.00 inches, 0.1 skeins)

DMC-3838 lavender blue - dk (21.65 inches, 0.1 skeins)

This is the 16th of the 31 patterns that I will be giving on my blog this month.

This pattern was inspired by the Mucha princess patterns Pinky the Pink has made, this one uses the colours of Elsa which you can find here: http://tinyurl.com/y99pgfab (if it hasn't sold out yet as it's a limited edition pattern). - The + in the centre is the middle of the pattern, marked for your stitching ease. The terra cotta backstitched line is the seam line of the stockings should you join them into a single stocking. I'd suggest whip stitching them together wrong sides facing.
- All the blue diagonal stitches are done with straight stitch so from one point to another with no stops on the way. All of the other lines are backstitch.
- If you don't like the colours then by all means change them, it's your project so you should make it in colours you enjoy!
