


This is the 17th of the 31 patterns that I will be giving on my blog over the month.

Today's pattern is a stylish white with gold repeat pattern inspired by an illuminated manuscript. If you like you can use beads for the 3 cross stitches in the middle of each diamond.

If you don't like the colours then by all means change them, it's your project so you should make it in colours you enjoy!

The + in the centre is the middle of the pattern, marked for your stitching ease. The black backstitched line is the seam line of the stockings should you join them into a single stocking. I'd suggest whip stitching them together wrong sides facing.
