

This is the 22nd of the 31 patterns that I will be giving on my blog over the month.

Today's pattern is a pattern I saw on an illuminated manuscript (and used on a small section of my Celtic Wolf embroidery) It looks so much better when you can see more of it!

If you think it's too much stitching you could always just do the darker red stitching on a red fabric instead.

If you don't like the colours then by all means change them, it's your project so you should make it in colours you enjoy!

The + in the centre is the middle of the pattern, marked for your stitching ease. The black backstitched line is the seam line of the stockings should you join them into a single stocking. I'd suggest whip stitching them together wrong sides facing.
