Christmas in July - Day 29 - Illuminated Square

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Grid Size: 96W x 64H

Design Area: 5.11" x 3.33" (92 x 60 stitches)

DMC-3777 terra cotta - vy dk (21.65 inches, 0.5 skeins)

This is the 29th of the 31 patterns that I will be giving on my blog over the month.

I love the background of the illumination and thought it was perfect for a small embroidery.

You really want to use a super shiny gold for this one - it needs to give off that rich sparkly illuminated manuscript vibe. I used 002J #4 Very Fine Braid as that was what I had on hand and it's glorious.

The terra cotta was chosen as it gives that old faded dark red feeling without going towards the pink shades, however if you prefer the sun-bleached look rather than the out of the sun colour change that age gives, then by all means choose a pinker colour.

The + in the centre is the middle of the pattern, marked for your stitching ease. The black backstitched line is the seam line of the stockings should you join them into a single stocking. I'd suggest whip stitching them together wrong sides facing.
