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Grid Size: 96W x 64H

Design Area: 5.11" x 3.33" (92 x 60 stitches)

Backstitch Lines:

— DMC-552 violet - md (219.14 inches, 0.2 skeins) — DMC-3777 terra cotta - vy dk (21.65 inches, 0.1 skeins)

This is the 30th of the 31 patterns that I will be giving on my blog this month.

This pattern was inspired by the Mucha princess patterns Pinky the Pink has made, this one uses the colours of Rapunzel which you can find here: http://tinyurl.com/l2wsvtx (if it hasn't sold out yet as it's a limited edition pattern). - The + in the centre is the middle of the pattern, marked for your stitching ease. The terra cotta backstitched line is the seam line of the stockings should you join them into a single stocking. I'd suggest whip stitching them together wrong sides facing.
- If you don't like the colours then by all means change them, it's your project so you should make it in colours you enjoy!
