



Christmas in July - Day 31 - Snow White

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Grid Size: 96W x 64H

Design Area: 5.11" x 3.33" (92 x 60 stitches)

Legend:

(*) Blended Entries:

DMC-3740 & DMC-3041 (DMC Cotton-antique violet - dk blended with DMC Cotton-antique violet - md)
DMC-3041 & DMC-3078 (DMC Cotton-antique violet - md blended with DMC Cotton-golden yellow - vy lt)

Backstitch Lines:

— KR4-002 Gold (74.04 inches, 0.2 skeins) — DMC-3777 terra cotta - vy dk (21.65 inches, 0.1 skeins)

Beads:

MHG-2011 Mill Hill Glass Beads-Victorian Gold (158 beads)

This is the 31st of the 31 patterns that I will be giving on my blog this month.

This pattern was inspired by the Mucha princess patterns Pinky the Pink has made, this one uses the colours of Snow White which you can find here: http://tinyurl.com/yc8ogpcu (if it hasn't sold out yet as it's a limited edition pattern). - The + in the centre is the middle of the pattern, marked for your stitching ease. The terra cotta backstitched line is the seam line of the stockings should you join them into a single stocking. I'd suggest whip stitching them together wrong sides facing.
- Please note that the blended colours are listed twice! Once as a normal colour in the main legend and once with the actual colours needed. Please read it all through before stash diving or buying colours as it will make it easier for you.
- All the gold star shapes are done like this: first do an X over 2x2 cross stitches, and then do a + over the top to finish the stitch off.
- When stitching the beads to the embroidery I suggest using the same colour thread as the background you are stitching on, so pink for the pink areas and blue for the blue areas. You can attach the beads the quick and "dirty" way: up through the hole where you want the bead to be, put the bead on your thread and then back down through the same hole. This does not give a very neat finish, better would be to do a sort of + or x with the needle going up and down halfway between the cross stitches.
- If you don't like the colours then by all means change them, it's your project so you should make it in colours you enjoy
